would you make your home in me?*

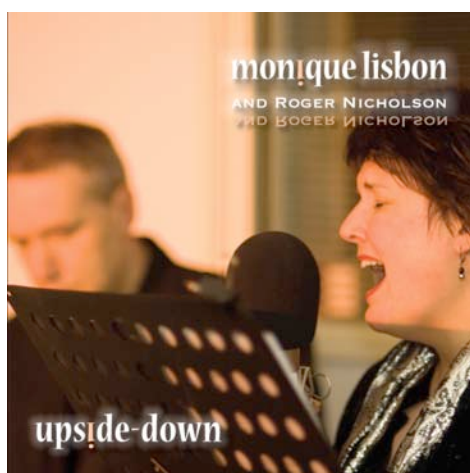
man of sorrows, what's your story?
