At a moment none can understand?

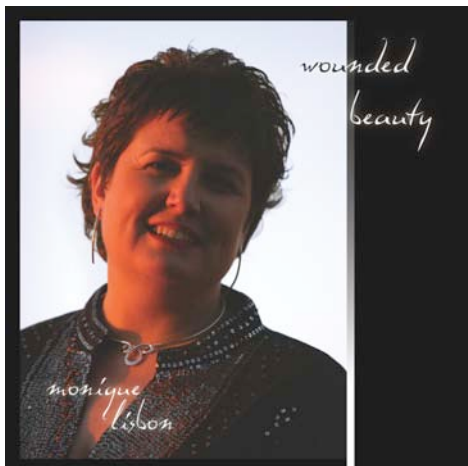
